Eligibility Rules

To be eligible for the End Semester Examination, a student must have submitted the examination form to the Office of the Dean (Academics) and satisfy the following attendance requirements:

- I. A student must maintain at least **75%** attendance in scheduled theory and practical classes. Failure to meet this requirement will make the student ineligible to appear in the examination for the concerned subject. A student detained due to attendance shortage may appear in the subsequent examination only after completing the required attendance when the course is offered again as a regular course.
- II. The Director may condone an attendance shortage of up to **10%** in genuine cases such as serious illness, natural calamities, or participation in approved sports and competitions. However, students with attendance below **65%** shall not be allowed to appear in the examination.
- III. Attendance shall be calculated up to seven days before the commencement of the End Semester Theory Examinations. The Dean (Academics) shall publish the list of ineligible students at least seven days before the examinations and inform the Controller of Examinations accordingly.
- IV. If a detained student is allowed to appear in the examination due to any oversight or error, the result declared for such a student shall be treated as invalid and cancelled.
